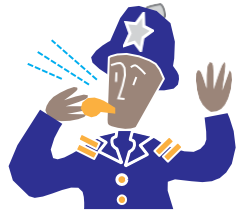

Show Rules



Entry Fee: 30p per entry

Prizes: First Prize - £1

1. All competitors must reside in the parishes of Fritwell, Ardley, Fewcott, Souldern and Somerton. Children staying with relatives in these parishes may enter.
2. All entry forms, together with fee must be given to the Show Secretary no later than the Wednesday before the show.
3. All fruit, flowers and vegetables must be grown by the exhibitor.
4. The committee reserve the right to inspect any produce entered in the show prior to it's staging and to inspect any garden or allotment, in necessary.
5. The judges decision is final and they have the authority to withhold any prize if they consider the produce to be below standard. All cooked foods must be covered.
6. All exhibits must be taken to Fritwell Village Hall between 8.30 and 11.00 am on the day of the show and may be removed after 4.30 pm.
7. Only one entry per person in all classes.
8. No persons other than officers of the show are allowed in the hall during judging.
9. All objections to be lodged in writing to the Show Secretary before 4.30 pm on the day of the show, together with a deposit of £1.00 which will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
10. The number of prizes an individual exhibitor may win is limited to one per class.
11. All plants and flowers must be in the exhibitor's possession not less than 3 months prior to the show date. All jams and jellies must have been made no more than 3 months prior to the show date. Chutneys must be made more than 3 months prior to the show date.
12. Any dispute not covered by these rules shall be decided by the Show Committee, whose decision is final.
13. In the event of a tie of the highest number of points, the exhibitor with the most first prizes will win.
14. Children's age and sex must be on the entry form for classes B1 to C7. Children should not put their name on their entries.
